

Children's Programming

The Brookline Public Library's Children's department selects, plans, and presents programs and events for the children of Brookline. These programs further library goals and are part of ongoing Library service. Programs and events sponsored by the Library are free of charge. Programs may be designed for a specific age or grade level, and attendance may be limited to a specifically described audience. If registration is required, priority will be given to Brookline residents and children of Town of Brookline employees, and will be done on a first-come, first-served basis.

Regularly offered programs (i.e. story times, book groups, etc.)

- Some may require registration.
 - Registration begins at least 3 weeks before the start of the session.
 - Parents are encouraged to bring only the child(ren) who is registered, if possible.
- Children must be the specified age for the program at the time the session begins.
- Promptness is greatly appreciated. Entering late can disrupt the program and those in attendance.

One-time programs

- Some may require registration. This is done in order to:
 - Not exceed the capacity of the room.
 - To ensure the audience meets all requirements.
 - To allow the presenter to adequately prepare for each child attending.
- Professional performers are selected by the Children's staff.
