## WHAT IS IT?

Our **SEWING MACHINES** will be available for in-library use or take-home borrowing!

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

**TWO THREADS** are interlocked between the layers of fabric.

**THE TOP THREAD** is fed by a spool, usually on the top of the machine.

**THE NEEDLE** on a sewing machine is usually threaded at the point.

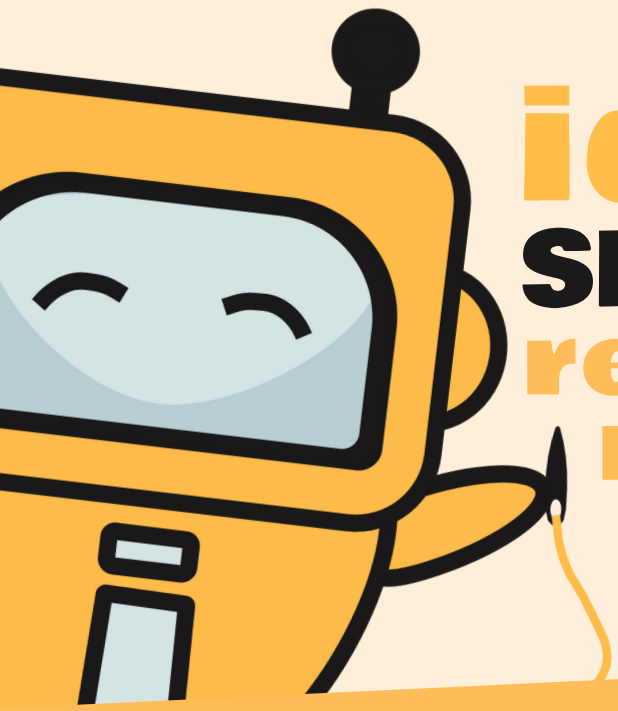
**THE BOBBIN** is a spool of thread that feeds the bottom thread to the machine.

**THE SHUTTLE HOOK** is the mechanism that interweaves the two threads.

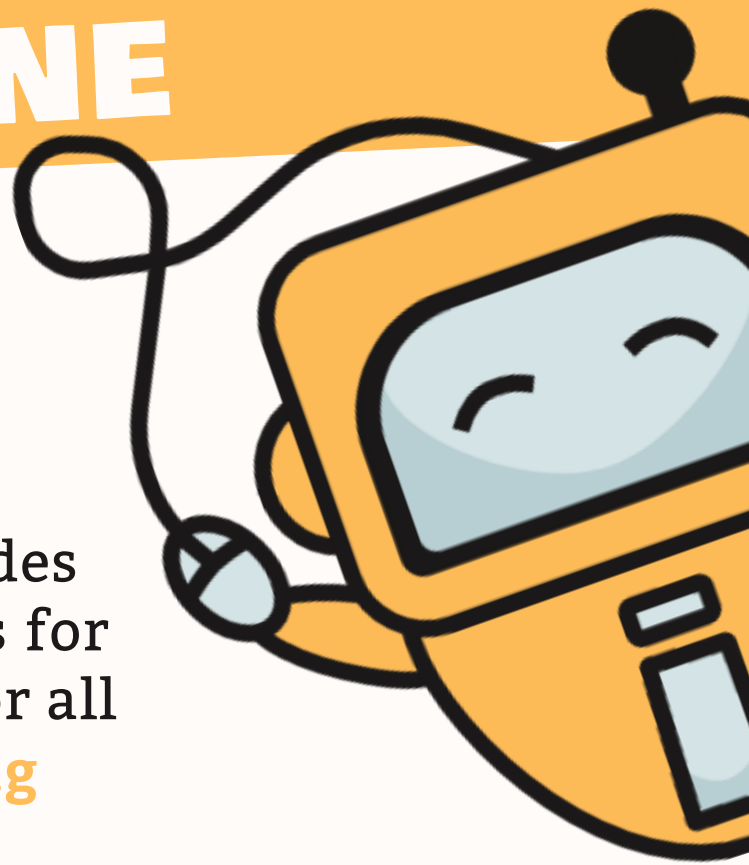
