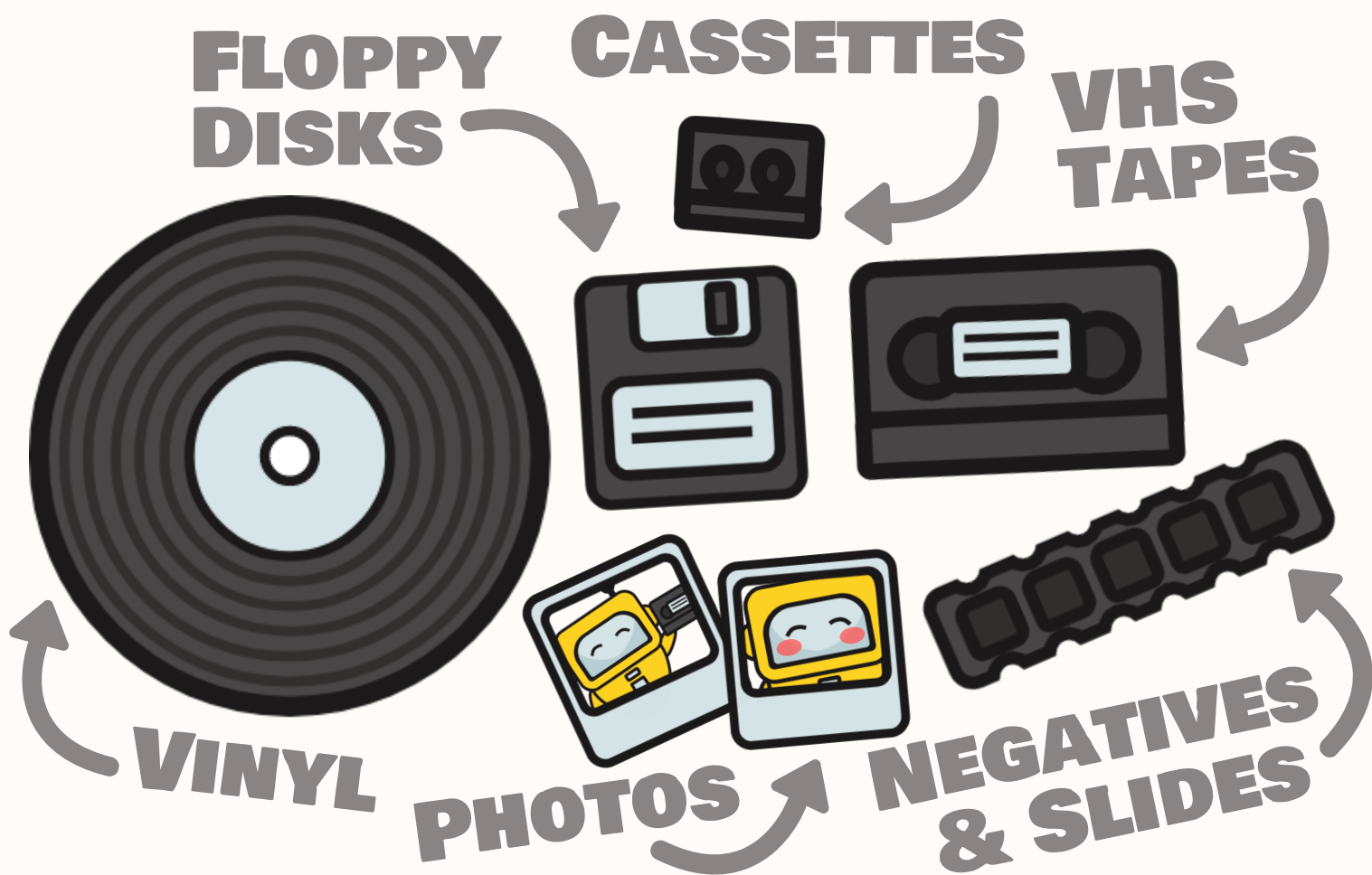

HOW DOES IT WORK?

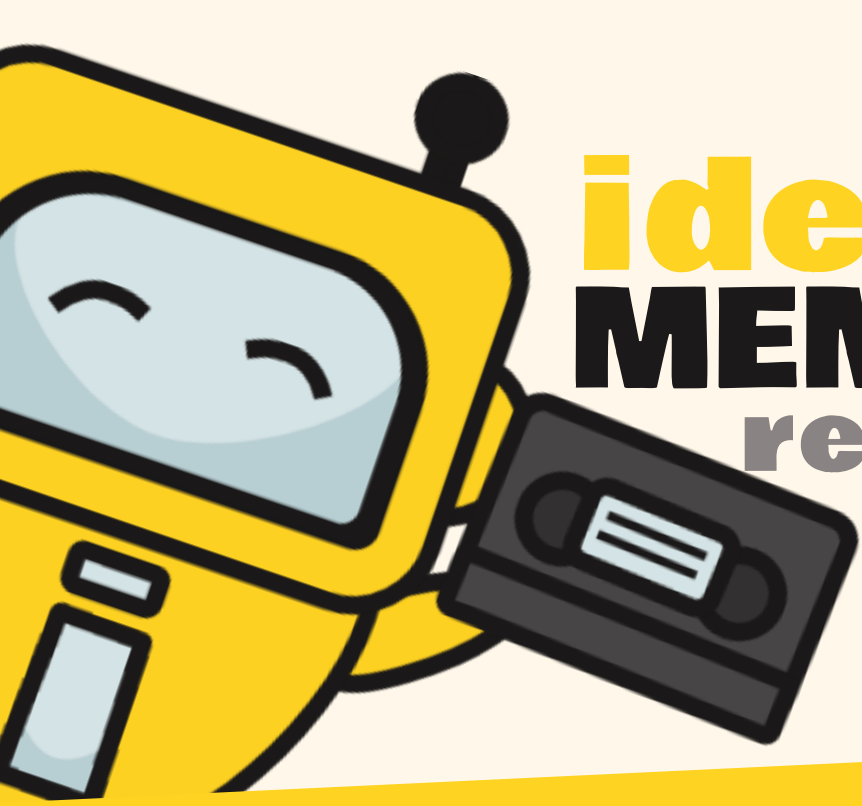
Just play your media through our computer system to make a digital copy that can be saved to a hard drive or disc! We have equipment to convert...
