

# **ART EXHIBITION SPACE INFORMATION COOLIDGE CORNER LIBRARY**

## **The Coolidge Corner Library's exhibit areas are as follows:**

### **1. Brick wall areas in and around the Library's central atrium:**

- 1 brick wall area approximately 12 feet in width along a ramp. This wall can accommodate medium- to large-size pieces.
- 3 brick wall areas approximately 5 feet in width. Each can accommodate 1-4 pieces, depending on size and hanging arrangement.

The total number of works this location can accommodate varies depending on the sizes of each piece. Overall, the Library can accommodate 20-32 pieces.

Framed work can be displayed using the provided hanging rod system. Rods are bent to fit over the molding. A hook slides up and down each rod when released, then locks and stays securely in place by the weight of the artwork hung over it. Rods are four, five, or six feet long; there are about 20 rods and 20 hooks.

### **2. Glass display case near the seating area at the front of the Library: 28" wide, 58" long, 8" high.**

The case is locked, with the key kept in a location restricted to staff. It has a plain white cardboard base that can be covered with cloth or paper. The glass is not treated to block UV or protect contents from exposure to light.
