Exhibit Space

The Coolidge Corner Library exhibit areas are as follows:

1. The brick walls in and around the central atrium:
 - The Atrium walls consist of one long wall (approximately 12 feet wide) along a ramp and three shorter walls (each approximately 5 feet wide)
 - The total number of pieces this space can accommodate varies depending on the size of each piece, but is generally between 20 to 32 pieces.
 - Framed work may be displayed using the provided hanging rod system.
 - Rods hang from the molding around the atrium.
 - A hook, when released, slides freely up and down each rod to adjust height. When locked, the hook is held securely in place by the weight of the artwork hung over it.
 - The rods come in lengths of four, five, and six feet.

2. A locked glass display case:
 - The case is 28 inches wide, 58 inches long, and 8 inches high.
 - The key for this case is kept in a restricted area available only to staff.
 - The interior of the case is plain white cardboard and may be covered in cloth or paper.
 - The glass is not treated to block UV light or to protect the contents of the case from light exposure.
