

## SENSORY STORY TIME AT THE BROOKLINE VILLAGE LIBRARY

I am going to visit the Brookline Village Library for sensory storytime.

I will go there with a grownup; my grownup will stay with me during the storytime.



The Brookline Village Library is at 361 Washington Street.



To get to the children's room, I can take the stairs or the elevator to the ground floor.



Or, I can come directly into the children's room through the children's garden entrance on the School St. side of the Library.



First, I get a ticket for the storytime at the children's desk.



The storytime will be in a room called the Rabbit Hole.



The librarian I will see is Miss Macy.



I can find a cushion to sit on, or if I want to, I can sit with my grownup.



We will sing, listen to stories, and move around!



If I want one, I can use a fidget or a lap pad.



If it is too loud, there are headphones for me to use.



If I want a break from storytime, I can tell my grownup and we can go into the Children's room. When I feel ready, we can come back. It is also OK to leave story time before the end if my grownup says it's OK.



Storytime will last about 30 minutes; at the end, there will be an activity! We might color or do an art project, we might play with building toys or blow bubbles. I can stay at the activity for as long as I'd like.



After the storytime, I might check out books or I might just go home.
